

# **AMERICA'S BEST HOTEL MINI BARS**

When was the last time you actually enjoyed having a mini bar in your hotel room? Simply opening it can lead to a steep bill at check-out time—whether or not you actually ate or drank anything. Another dilemma: Run-of-the-mill options like a can of Miller Lite or a tin of Pringles are less than thrilling. Thankfully, a handful of boutique hotels across the US now offer locally sourced snacks and drinks, and some don't even charge a penny (except for the alcohol, of course). From New York City to West Hollywood to Nashville, here are the 10 best hotel mini-bars you'll be happy to have in your room.

#### ANDAZ WEST HOLLYWOOD

Where: West Hollywood, California

Mini-bar contents are free at Andaz West Hollywood and replenished daily, including Pop Chips, trail mix, Coca-Cola products, sparkling water, and granola bars. Tack on the Brunette and Blonde beers from Fireman's Brew, based in nearby Woodland Hills, for an extra fee.

Insider Tip: Take those free snacks to the hotel's rooftop pool: The Sundeck is Los Angeles' highest pool and boasts panoramic views of the Hollywood Hills.

## THE GREENWICH HOTEL

Where: New York City

Mini-bars at The Greenwich Hotel feature co-owner Robert De Niro's favorite snacks, such as Tate's Bake Shop chocolate-chip cookies, Uncle Jerry's pretzels, Jujyfruits, Oreos and M&Ms—all refreshed daily and at no cost. Also in the mini-bar—for a small fee—are gin, bourbon, sherry, scotch, tequila, beer, and red and white wine.

Insider Tip: Jars of sweet and salty treats throughout each room satisfy midnight munchies.

#### THE LITTLE NELL

Where: Aspen, Colorado

Known as a foodie and wine-lover's destination, The Little Nell's mini-bars flaunt Colorado producers. This includes New Belgium Brewing Company's Fat Tire flagship beer, locally made chocolates, and Boulder Canyon Natural Foods potato chips. Snacks and non-alcoholic drinks are complimentary and replenished daily.

Insider Tip: Stave away altitude sickness with canned oxygen, which is also in the mini-bar.

## **HOTELRED**

Where: Madison, Wisconsin

Naturally, HotelRED's mini-bar has a Wisconsin craft beer or two, including Lakefront Brewery and New Glarus Brewing Company. But that's not all: State-made spirits include Death's Door Spirits vodka and gin, Yahara Bay Distillers rum, and Quince & Apple tart-cherry grenadine. Locally made nibbles include chocolate-covered cranberries and Nueske's beef sticks.

Insider Tip: In-room mixology is encouraged: Consult your cocktail-recipe book and use a shaker and shot glass. You'll find tonic and club soda in the mini-bar and fresh fruits at the front desk.

#### THE HERMITAGE

Where: Nashville, Tennessee

From Olive & Sinclair's bean-to-bar chocolates to the locally famous Truffle Babies from Colts Chocolates, almost everything in the mini-bar at The Hermitage Hotel is local. Health nuts will appreciate the granola bars, cashews, and honey-roasted peanuts, plus juices. You'll also find a bottle of Jack Daniel's in the mini-bar, honoring Jack Daniel's Distillery that's a 90-minute drive away.

Insider Tip: Still not satisfied with the stash? Request your favorite snacks and beverages before arrival.

#### **CALISTOGA RANCH**

Where: Napa Valley, California

A wine-growing region isn't likely to skimp on gourmet snacks, and Calistoga Ranch is no exception. Upon arrival, mini-bars are filled with Coca-Cola beverages, coconut water, vitamin water, cracked-pepper crackers, 18 Rabbits granola bars (which are made in the Bay Area), olive tapenade (from nearby St. Helena), cinnamon bears and fresh fruit—at no cost. Just remember that there's a restocking fee.

Insider Tip: Other treats are also free: one bottle of Calistoga Ranch Chardonnay or Cabernet Sauvignon, a product of the resort's on-site vineyard.

# **ENCHANTMENT RESORT**

Where: Sedona, Arizona

The Enchantment Resort recently swapped out large-production beers in its mini-bars for local craft beers: Grand Canyon Brewing Company's Pilsner and Oak Creek Brewing Co.'s Amber. The hotel also adds two bottles of Arizona wines, chocolate-covered wine grapes, jalapeno almonds, and Yavapai trail mix (crafted in the state) to each room.

Insider Tip: Pack up those snacks and head out for a hike in the surrounding Boynton Canyon.

## **TIDES INN**

Where: Irvington, Virginia

With bottles of locally made wines (one white, one red) plus two local craft beers (brewed in Williamsburg and Lexington), the Tides Inn mini-bar quenches a locavore's thirst. Pair your beverages with another state product, Virginia peanuts, which you'll also find in the mini-bar.

Insider Tip: Turndown service includes a bottle of locally made ginger ale.

### **OCEAN HOUSE**

Where: Watch Hill, Rhode Island

At the classy, swanky Ocean House hotel, the mini-bar is flush with beverages and snacks are stored in glass jars. It's all completely free and restocked at no cost. Selections change regularly, but at the moment they feature bottled water, soft drinks, and snacks (malt balls, Goldfish crackers, and trail mix). For young kids, gummy bears, fruit snacks, and peanuts are available upon request.

Insider Tip: Bottomless cups of hot chocolate—perfect for braving cool mornings on the beach—are also free to hotel guests.

# **CASTLE HOTEL AND SPA**

Where: Tarrytown, New York

At Castle Hotel & Spa, a half hour north of Manhattan, liquid contents in the mini-bar are replenished daily—including water, non-alcoholic beverages, and Captain Lawrence Brewing Company beer (brewed in nearby Elmsford). Sip them near your wood-burning fireplace (available in some rooms) while listening to Tivoli Radio and Bose Sound systems (offered in all rooms).

Insider Tip: Upgrade to a luxury suite and receive free spirits (Grey Goose vodka and Chivas whiskey) in your mini-bar.
